The success of piloting the GreenGenerations project activities at Centrul Județean de Excelență Galați

In Galaţi, the Galaţi County Excellence Center successfully hosted the piloting of educational activities within the GreenGenerations European project, an initiative dedicated to intergenerational education for a sustainable future. The program involved 6 teachers, 118 students, and 57 parents and external specialists, strengthening the partnership between school, family, and community in promoting responsible ecological practices.

As part of this innovative program, students participated in interactive and experiential activities aimed at developing their knowledge of sustainability. Topics covered included recycling, energy conservation, responsible use of natural resources, and the design of eco-friendly homes. Through practical experiments, educational games, and applied projects, children developed a positive attitude toward environmental protection.

Teachers appreciated the interdisciplinary approach and innovative methods used in the activities, emphasizing their effectiveness in stimulating critical thinking, collaboration, and active student engagement. Parents also played an essential role in the implementation of the project, actively participating in learning sessions and community initiatives aimed at supporting the transition to a more sustainable lifestyle.

"It is essential that environmental education should begin at an early age, and this project demonstrates that the direct involvement of students and parents can have a significant impact on the ecological behavior of our community," said Professor Dr. Maria-Isabela Miron, the coordinator of the piloting at Centrul Județean de Excelență Galați. The success of this piloting demonstrates the potential of the GreenGenerations project to become a replicable educational model at the national and European levels. The conclusions and best practices derived from the project will contribute to improving the project curriculum and developing future initiatives in the field of sustainability education.
