Teacher Training Package on Intergenerational Climate Change Education

The training package offers capacity building tools and resources for building teachers' skills towards the pedagogical approach of intergenerational climate change education.

This training package addresses the current gap in climate change education by providing teachers with capacity-building tools and resources focused on intergenerational pedagogy.

The modules include an introduction to intergenerational climate change education, teaching principles in intergenerational learning, application of innovative teaching techniques, and methods for assessing learning and influence levels between students, parents and the community.

The goal is to equip teachers with the skills needed to shift from a fact-based approach to fostering active intergenerational learning, promoting collective action, and changing unsustainable behaviors.

The training package will be available for free usage on the project's website in January 2024!

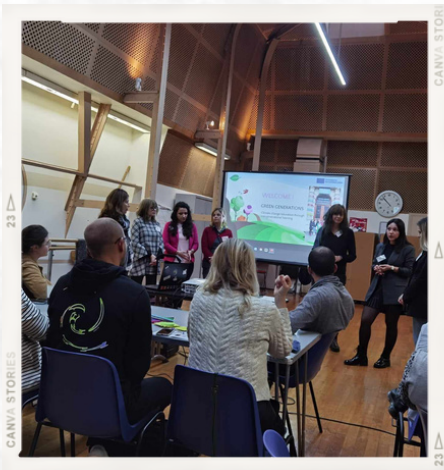
