About the project

The GreenGenerations project is highly focused on the essential priority of caring for the environment and combating climate change by enabling the emergence of a climate resilient society.

Convinced that the education of the younger generations is a powerful lever for change, six European partners from five countries (Romania, France, Bulgaria, Greece, Cyprus), with complementary expertise in social innovation and pedagogical engineering, have gathered to develop innovative pedagogical modules on climate change education through intergenerational learning processes.

This new approach will enable young learners to develop new skills, voice their ideas, lead their project and collaborate with adults (teachers, parents and other people from their close ecosystem) to overcome barriers, address climate change concerns and seek sustainable solutions.

The project promotes teachers' continuous profession development as it offers them the opportunity to discover and implement an innovative school curriculum and various non-formal learning activities in the field of climate change education.

- 2) GreenGenerations Curriculum - innovative lesson plans and educations activities
- 3) An interactive educational platform where teachers, parents and students can exchange environmentally friendly knowledge and experiences



Research of teachers' training needs

This first project milestone is the research on teachers' knowledge, needs and gaps in the field of intergenerational learning and climate change education. The partners conducted national research, questionnaires and focus groups that set the ground for the development of training materials.

Kick-off Meeting



The first partner meeting was organized in Paris, France, on 8th-9th December 2022. It was hosted by the project coordinator Eutopique at the Académie du Climat, to mark the project's official launch. The active two day kick-off meeting focused on the overview of the project's main goals, activities and work plan for the duration of the project (30 months). The partners set the ambitious goal to create unique innovative educational tools to support teachers in addressing new learning opportunities for their students in the field of climate change education through intergenerational learning projects.
